Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing just 4 people. Overall sales for that particular year amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. At present, Cascade is among the leading international makers within the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively engage in better business opportunities. All through the final sixty years, the business of material handling has grown into a really sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade at present continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck attachments and different associated items. The company feels confident in their skill to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and promoting hydraulic accessories. Construction was finished in the year 1956 on a new office in order to house all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. After 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 staff and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second production plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry while the business recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental US to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made globally due to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in forks.
